- The top 16 applicants, based on the recommendation note and application, will be notified by email.
- Unsuccessful applicants will also be notified by email.
- Preference will be given to students who have taken Law 10, 20 or 30 (although this is not a requirement).
- The program cost is free; however, students will be responsible for the cost of the criminal record check (approximately \$60.00).
- Students will be responsible for their own lunch during the week.
