COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is an introduction to the law of trusts in Canada. Students will be introduced to the concept of a trust and the nature of equitable property rights and will study the creation of trusts by intention and by operation of law, the variation and termination of trusts, trusts for charitable purposes, the personal and property rights of trust beneficiaries, the powers, duties and liabilities of trustees, and the liabilities of others who become involved in a breach of trust.
